- It is recommended to have a **high-speed internet connection** to ensure smooth and uninterrupted access to the study materials.

Mandatory Requirements

Mandatory Requirements

- Completing **mandatory assessments** (a total of 22 Assessments) with a minimum score of 60% in each is mandatory to appear for the final exam.
- Attendance at a minimum of **4 contact sessions** is mandatory to qualify for the final exam.

Optional : The course has a section on **Exercises (3 exercises)**. The exercises are only for self-learning. Exercises will not be graded and will not be counted for the final result.





Examination Instructions

- The examination will be conducted via online
- Maximum marks: **50 marks**
- Duration : **60 mins**
- Exam pattern: 50 x 1 = 50 (MCQ)
- Access to the examination will be available for a limited time on the scheduled exam date.
- You will be asked to **switch on your camera during the exam**. Therefore, please ensure you have access to a desktop or laptop.
- Once you start accessing the question paper, exactly after 60 minutes the access will be automatically closed.
- Make yourself free for 60 minutes continuously and ensure that you have uninterrupted internet connection.
- After completing your exam, kindly finish your attempt and submit the answers otherwise, it will only be in the draft.
- The examination results will be published on the online portal, and candidates will be notified.





During the Exam

- **Prepare Your Environment:** Sit in a well-lit, closed room with no distractions or noise.
- **Power & Internet:** Ensure at least one hour of power backup and a stable, high-speed internet connection. If using a mobile hotspot, keep your phone connected to the charger and avoid making or receiving calls.
- **System Check:** Use a Windows PC or laptop with a functioning webcam and microphone.
- **Avoid Disruptions:** Do not access other websites or consult with others during the exam.
- **Time Management:** MOHAN Foundation is not responsible for any time lost due to issues with your computer, hardware, software, internet connectivity, or power.





During the Exam

- **AI Monitoring:** Be aware that AI tools may monitor your activities, facial expressions, and pupil movements during the exam.
- **Navigating Questions:** Use the question palette or dropdown menus to move between questions.
- **Saving Answers:** Ensure your answers are saved by maintaining a stable internet connection.
- **Warning Signs: Only 10 warning signs** are permitted; If the number exceeds this, the exam will automatically shut down.
- **No Recording:** Do not take photos or record videos of the exam session.
- **Submission:** You may submit your exam and exit after 60 minutes from the start time.
- **Mock examination:** Anytime during the course and on the day of exam





Reattempt



Reattempt option is available **only one more time** for candidates who:

- ✓ Did not complete the mandatory requirements
- ✓ Did not qualify in the final exam, or
- ✓ Were unable to attend the exam on the scheduled date, or
- **Reattempt fee is Rs. 500/-**
- The reattempt exam will be held within few weeks after the first examination.
- Applying for the reattempt is candidates' decision. However, if the candidate does not submit the reattempt application and pay the required fee at least three days before the examination, the candidate will not be permitted to take the reattempt.





Certification

- Minimum passing grade requires achieving **60% (30 out of 50 marks)** in the online examination
- **Feedback submission** is mandatory
